As part of our ongoing partnership with Chicago Ideas Week (CIW), Horizons for Youth was specially chosen for a unique group session with Hakeem Oluseyi, an astrophysicist, educator, and inventor, who has also served as a TV host for the Science Channel, the Discovery Channel, and National Geographic.

Dr. Oluseyi spoke with five of our students for nearly an hour about his journey to become one of the top astrophysicists in the country and one of the most respected and innovative scientific minds of his generation. Our students also benefitted from his story about having to overcome his initial lack of preparedness for college and graduate school due to his deficiencies in math.

The once-in-a-lifetime nature of this opportunity was not lost on our students, who asked intelligent questions and remained completely engaged throughout the entirety of the session. Horizons for Youth sophomore student Gabe said: "[Dr. Oluseyi] has an incredible story of overcoming adversity. After the session, I let him know how inspired I was, and he told me that my story can end up the same way as long as I stick with it."

The students of Horizons for Youth were not the only ones who treasured the experience—in fact, it was Dr. Oluseyi whose excitement led him to extend the session to nearly twice its scheduled running time! A public relations representative in attendance with Dr. Oluseyi remarked that our students were some of the most impressive that she has ever met, adding that she was in awe of our students' enthusiasm and eagerness to explore such challenging topics.
