



## Licensed Therapist Position Description

### **Position Overview:**

Horizons for Youth is seeking a PART-TIME licensed therapist (**LCSW, LCPC, or LMFT**) to support Horizons for Youth families. The therapist will work for 2-8 hours per week VIRTUALLY to provide ongoing counseling services to families, individual students, or groups of clients.

### **Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Perform short term counseling to address topics such as:
  - Trauma
  - Anxiety/depression
  - Anger management/conflict resolution
  - Violence/Domestic Violence
  - Grief and loss
  - Healthy relationships
  - Life skills and personal goal setting
  - Self-esteem
  - Dealing with learning or behavioral diagnoses
  - Support Groups/ Parent Cafes
  
- Ensure clients are making progress toward personal goals
- Maintain detailed records about each family
- Prospect community-based organizations or individuals that can provide additional mental health support to Horizons for Youth families
- Potential to conduct trainings with staff or parents to raise awareness about mental health

needs and share tools for promoting parent and student self-esteem, self-efficacy, and ability to resolve conflict

- Report to Senior Director, Program Services, engage in monthly counselor meetings and turn in timesheets bi-weekly

- Minimum two years of experience working with children and parents in a clinical setting
- Experience working in urban environments and familiarity with multicultural groups
